Regarding: Aluminum or Stainless Steel Cabinets made by Dwyer Products, a Millenia Products Group Company

The cabinets made of non-ferrous materials are very easily recycled by a recycler such as Reynolds Recycling, and we would appreciate the opportunity to purchase the scrap metal they are made of.

Specifically, the cabinets made of Stainless or Electrogalvanized Steel (18 or 20 gauge), or Aluminum (18 gauge) material are almost entirely made out of these materials, and while they appear to have small amounts of ferrous or other metal contamination, these should be easily removable to ensure a product that would be very recyclable. We buy non-contaminated stainless or aluminum materials currently at 10 or 20 cents per pound respectively.

This recyclability would leave a highly desirable and valuable material that insures that these products are both green in the sense that they are good for the environment during their use, but are equally good for the environment when they are recycled. They would be good for the owners of these cabinets as well as these cabinets would provide an additional material value when recycled, after the cabinets have ceased to be useable or necessary for their owners.
